Do not Steal the Joyful Married Life (24:1-5)

Marriage is a Picture of the Life God Has Given Israel

Malachi 2:13-16

13 [The Lord does not accept their offerings] 14 But you say, "Why does he not?" Because the Lord was witness between you and the wife of your youth, to whom you have been faithless, though she is your companion and your wife by covenant. 15 Did he not make them one, with a portion of the Spirit in their union? And what was the one God seeking? Godly offspring. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and let none of you be faithless to the wife of your youth. 16 "For the man who does not love his wife but divorces her, says the Lord, the God of Israel, covers his garment with violence, says the Lord of hosts. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and do not be faithless."

Legal Adultery (1-4)

⁴ **then her former husband**, who sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, after *she has been defiled*, <u>for that is an abomination before the Lord</u>. And you shall not bring sin upon the land that the Lord your God is giving you for an inheritance.

(Cf. Jesus – porneia; Matt 5:31–32; 19:7–9; Mark 10:4–12)

Rights of Newlyweds (5)

⁵ "When a man is newly married, he shall not go out with the army or be liable for any other public duty. He shall be *free at home one year* to be happy with his wife whom he has taken.

Sexual Satisfaction found in Marriage

Proverbs 5:15–23

¹⁵ Drink water from your own cistern, flowing water from your own well. ¹⁶ Should your springs be scattered abroad, streams of water in the streets? ¹⁷ Let them be for yourself alone, and not for strangers with you. ¹⁸ Let your fountain be blessed, and rejoice in the wife of your youth, ¹⁹ a lovely deer, a graceful doe. *Let her breasts fill you at all times with delight*; be intoxicated always in her love. ²⁰ Why should you be intoxicated, my son, with a forbidden woman and embrace the bosom of an adulteress? ²¹ For a man's ways are before the eyes of the Lord, and he ponders all his paths. ²² The iniquities of the wicked ensnare him, and he is held fast in the cords of his sin. ²³ He dies for lack of discipline, and because of his great folly he is led astray.

A Good Marriage is Not the Ultimate Point (Our Need & His Grace) Jeremiah 3:1

"If a man divorces his wife and she goes from him and becomes another man's wife, will he return to her? Would not that land be greatly polluted? *You have played the whore with many lovers*; and *would you return to me*? declares the Lord.

Isaiah 54:5-6

⁵ For **your Maker is your husband**, the LORD of hosts is his name; and the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called. ⁶ For *the LORD has called you like a wife deserted* and *grieved in spirit*, like *a wife of youth when she is cast off*, says your God.

Do not Steal the Life of a Brother (24:6-7)

⁶ "No one shall take a mill or an upper millstone in pledge, for that would be *taking a life* in pledge.

⁷ "If a man is found stealing one of his brothers of the people of Israel, and if he *treats him as a slave or sells him*, then *that thief shall die*. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.

Deuteronomy 23:15–16

¹⁵ "You shall not give up to his master **a slave who has escaped** from his master to you. ¹⁶ He shall dwell with you, in your midst, in the place that he shall choose within one of your towns, wherever it suits him. *You shall not wrong him*.

Giving Our Life for God & Brothers

What Life Do We Value?

Acts 20:24, 33–35

²⁴ But I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. ...

³³ <u>I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel</u>. ³⁴ You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities and to those who were with me. ³⁵ In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.""

Do we believe it is better to give our lives for our brothers and our God?

The Example of the Prophet Hosea (1:1)
Why did you (or do you want to) get married?
We have played the whore!
We are trying to take life instead of give it!

Consider the Love of Our Faithful Husband!

Ephesians 5:1-2

¹ Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. ² And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

Ephesians 5:25–27

²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, as *Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her*, ²⁶ that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, ²⁷ so that

he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.

Luke 17:1-4

¹ And he said to his disciples, "Temptations to sin are sure to come, but woe to the one through whom they come! ² It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck and he were cast into the sea than that he should cause one of these little ones to sin. ³ Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him, ⁴ and if he sins against you seven times in the day, and turns to you seven times, saying, 'I repent,' you must forgive him."
